Pickup and Drop-Off Times (by appointment only)

- Please arrange your appointment time in advance.
 - Services outside of regular hours, weekends, and holidays may incur a \$20 surcharge.
 - Boarding must be booked a minimum of 48 hours in advance.
 - Please provide a valid ID and copies of any vaccines for our records.
 - All client information is kept confidential and securely stored.
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Vaccinations

For care within our home, please supply copies of valid vaccines, as well as any deworming or flea treatments. Flea treatment is strongly recommended and can be administered for a \$10 fee. You acknowledge that you accept full responsibility if your pets are not vaccinated.

Charges and Payments

- A 25% deposit may be required at the time of booking.
 - We accept cash or e-transfer. Payment is due in full upon pickup for boarding, along with any additional service charges incurred during the stay.
 - Reservations cancelled up to 48 hours in advance will receive a full deposit refund.
 - If there is a "no-show" at the booked service time, 50% of the boarding fee will be charged.
 - We are not responsible for paying any groomer, vet, or store invoices. However, we can accept advance payment on your behalf for pre-verified costs, with a 15% service fee.
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Feeding, Playtime, and Care

- Please ensure you leave or bring sufficient food and medications for your pet's stay. We are happy to prepare food to suit their preferences.
 - We can also pick up food or litter on your behalf while you're away, for an additional fee.
 - High-quality, grain-free dry and wet food & clumping clay litter or wood pellets are provided free of charge to cats. Alternatives can be provided for an additional fee—please specify any requests during your pre-service visit.
 - We provide various treats, including freeze-dried meats, dried fish, and grain-free crunchy snacks, free of charge. Notify us of any dietary restrictions or allergies in the pet information form.
 - For hygiene reasons, we do not accept pet beds or litter boxes. Towels or blankets are acceptable. We provide beds, bowls, treats, accessories, and toys.
 - Please bring an item that smells like home (e.g., a favorite brush or toy) for added comfort. We are not responsible for lost or damaged items.
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Veterinary Care and Medication

- Any pre-existing conditions or illnesses must be discussed prior to care. Medications should be provided with clear written instructions for dosage and administration, and we will administer them at no extra charge.
 - Any vet trips or medication refills while in our care may incur an additional fee.
 - We will use our preferred veterinarian unless otherwise specified in the registration form.
 - In the event of illness or incidents, owners will be contacted immediately to decide how to proceed with care. If we cannot reach you or your emergency contact, we will proceed with veterinary care on your behalf.
 - Owners are responsible for all veterinary charges. Any consultation fees paid on your behalf must be reimbursed within 7 days.
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Hygiene and Safety

- All pets accepted into our care are at the owner's risk. Incidents may occur, and we have safety measures in place to prevent them.
 - Aggressive behavior must be discussed in advance, and we reserve the right to refuse service to aggressive or untrained pets.
 - We do not board pets that require sedatives, muzzles, or other restrictive devices.
 - If a pet is not collected at the end of their stay or fees are unpaid, legal action will be taken. Pets will be considered abandoned after 1 week of no contact and may be taken to a shelter or rehomed.
